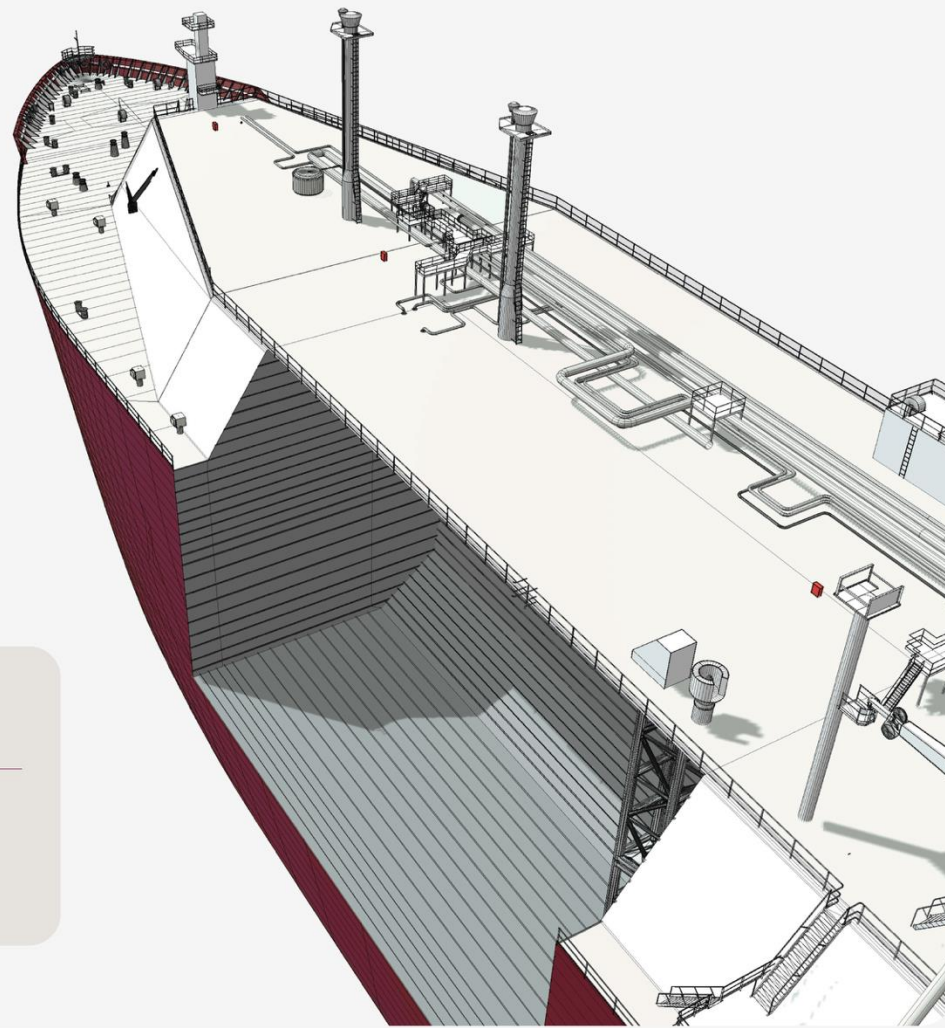

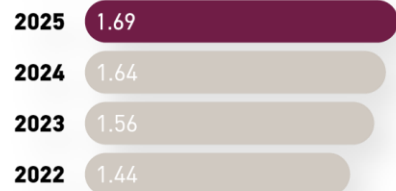

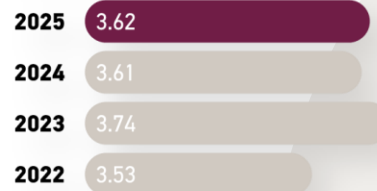
NET PROFIT (BILLION QAR)



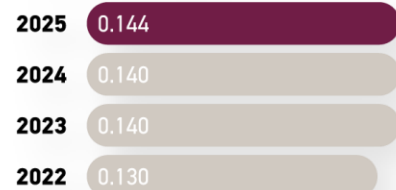
TOTAL INCOME (BILLION QAR)



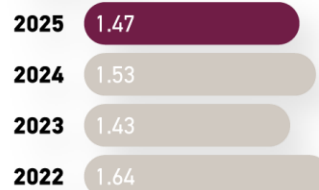
EBITDA (BILLION QAR)



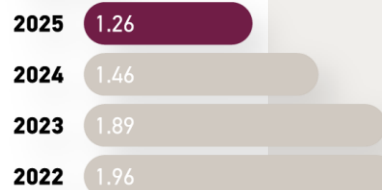
DIVIDEND PER SHARE (QAR)



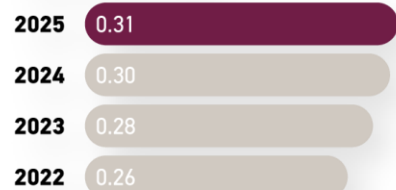

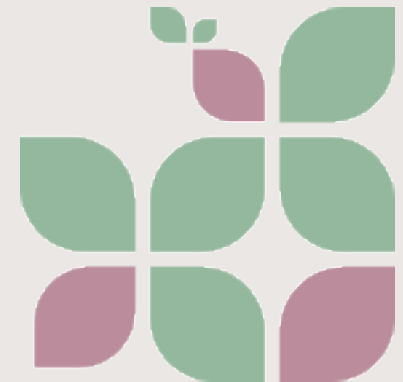


OUR JOURNEY TOWARDS SUSTAINABILITY

 - ME-GI Conversion retrofit
 - TFDE & DFDE (Dual & Tri Fuel Propulsion)
 - X-DF & ME-GI engines propulsion which is proven to be more fuel efficient and more environmentally friendly due to the lower Carbon emissions.
- ◆ All of Nakilat's fleet has been retrofitted with the Ballast Water Treatment System.
